EMISSION-RELATED INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR VESSEL MANUFACTURERS AS EPA REGULATION 1042.130

This engine is intended for use in a recreation vessel, it cannot be fitted into a commercial vessel.

To comply with EPA regulation 1042.130 whilst installing this engine into your vessel it must be carried out as detailed in Beta Marine Installation Guide and Operator's Manual -Section 1 Installation guidelines.

Failing to follow these instructions when installing a certified engine in a vessel violates federal law (40 CFR 1068.105(b)), subject to fines or other penalties as described in the Clean Air Act.

These instructions include ventilation, engine mounting, installation angle, alignment, coupling, exhaust requirements in respect of installation of heat exchanger cooled engines, and fuel supply and return system.

Certification of this engine is subject to use in variable speed applications. The internal speed governor must not be adjusted to suit a constant speed application

To ensure engine is installed according to design specification, particular attention must be given to exhaust back pressure, keeping it as low as possible. Maximum permissible exhaust back pressure is detailed and described within Beta Marine Installation Guide and Operator's Manual -Section 1 Installation guidelines -Exhaust back pressure.

If you install the engine in a way that makes the engine's emission control information label hard to read during normal engine maintenance, you must place a duplicate label on the vessel, as described in 40 CFR 1068.105.

This statement is intended to ensure each installer is informed of the required installation requirements. It is to be supplied with each engine, a copy is available upon request.
